Australian year 12 students can apply for up to five courses, including your dream course. With options including double degrees, undergraduate degrees, and pathway programs, you can map out the rest of your academic journey with certainty and flexibility.

Some courses, like Paramedicine and Medicine, aren't part of this program, due to competitive entry. However, you can still include them in your early application, and they'll be assessed after your ATAR is released. Early offers may still be made for your other course preferences.

No matter where you're at, we've got your back

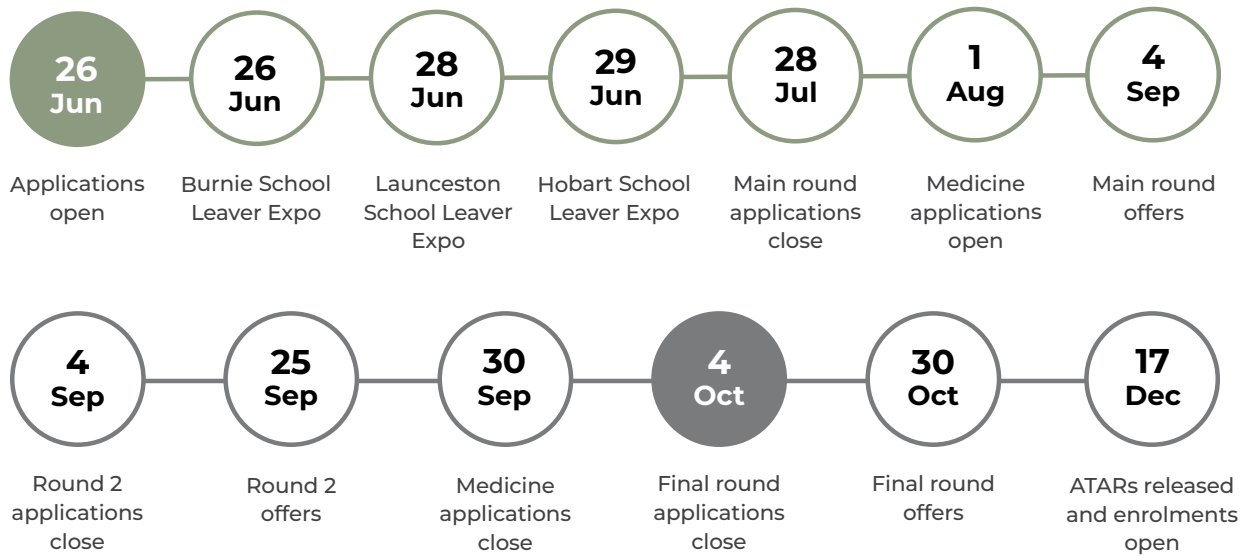
If you don't receive an offer for your dream course through the program, don't worry. You'll be assessed again after your ATAR is released. If you don't receive an offer through the program or your ATAR, we also offer pathway programs as another entryway to uni study. These include the Diploma of University Studies, which equips you with the skills to complete your chosen bachelor's degree.

How to order your course preferences

In your application, you'll be asked to add up to 5 courses.

Here's how to choose their order.

1st preference	Desired course	This is your dream course.
2nd preference 3rd preference 4th preference	Courses of interests*	These are other courses you're interested in studying. <i>These are particularly important if your course isn't included in the program or if your first preference has high entry requirements.</i>
5th preference	Pathway course	A course that will support your personal learning journey and help you upgrade into a preferred course on completion.

**If you don't meet the entry requirements, you will be offered a pathway option to your course offer.*
